Exhibit A History & Factors of Family Violence (Petitioner should initial ALL that apply. Respondent is the defendant.)

	History 1. Choking of petitioner.
	2. Respondent has destroyed, or threatened to destroy, the personal property of the petitioner.
	3. Increasing frequency and severity of violence against petitioner.
	4. Number of times within the past ninety (90) days when violence has occurred between the parties.
	5. Respondent has threatened petitioner with a knife, gun or other deadly weapon or threatened to ki petitioner.
	6. History of prior calls to law enforcement and/or prior filings for protective orders.
	7. History of defying protective orders or law enforcement.
	8. History of substance abuse. Respondent assaults petitioner when drunk or high.
_	9. Stalking of petitioner by respondent.
	10. Excessive jealousy and excessive control of petitioner. Currently threatens petitioner because he/she believes that petitioner is cheating with another.
	11. Respondent has expressed fantasies about homicide or suicide.
	12. Respondent has killed or injured pets or threatened to do so.
	13. Respondent has threatened or attempted suicide.
	14. Respondent exercises "ownership rights" over the petitioner. Or, respondent has told petitioner words to the effect, "You are mine, if I can't have you no one can."
	15. Respondent threatens to injure or flee with petitioner's children. Or, has done so in the past.
	16. Respondent has mental health impairment, such as depression or schizophrenia or paranoia.
	17. Respondent has threatened to take petitioner hostage or has a history of hostage taking, with or without law enforcement intervention.
	18. (Optional) Respondent has forced petitioner to have sex against will of petitioner.
	FACTORS
	19. Parties have recently separated.
	20. Gun present in home or readily accessible to respondent.
	21. Petitioner believes that the respondent may try to use deadly force against petitioner.
	22. (Optional) Petitioner has begun a new relationship with a new partner.
